

40th Anniversary of the Inaugural Run – Sunday 22nd May 2016

Inaugural Club Run – Sunday 23rd May 1976 – Roselands to Woronora –organised by who?

- 9.00am - Turn Right into Centre Avenue from Roselands Aquatic Centre carpark.
 - Turn Left at next intersection towards Canterbury Road
 - 0.3km - Turn Left at Second Roundabout into Payten Avenue
 - 0.6km - Straight On past 98 Payten Avenue – what was this address known for?
 - 0.9km - Turn Left at Roundabout into Bonds Road.
 - Straight On through 2 roundabouts
 - 1.8km - pass under South Western Motorway – not there 40 years ago.
 - 2.5km - Veer left under railway line – you are still on Bonds Road
 - Straight On through roundabout at Broad Arrow Road
 - 2.9km - Veer left at roundabout – still on Bonds Road
 - 3.7km - Turn Right at lights at Forrest Road towards Menai / Milperra – stay in left lane.
 - 5.8km - Cross over Salt Pan Creek
 - 6.9km - Just over crest, veer left into Alford's Point Road towards Menai/Wollongong
 - Watch through traffic as you merge onto Alford's Point Bridge – was bridge here in 1976?
 - 9.6km - Take next exit to Illawong
 - 10.4km - Turn Right at roundabout into Old Illawarra Road, towards Menai/Sutherland
 - 11.3km - Straight on over Alford's Point Road
 - 12.9km - Turn Right at lights onto New Illawarra Road, towards Sutherland/Wollongong
 - 17.3km - Pass ANSTO at Lucas Heights. What was ANSTO known as in 1976?
 - 19.1km - Turn Left at lights onto Heathcote Road, towards Wollongong
 - 21.9km - Cross Woronora River
 - 24.5km - Turn Right at lights onto Princes Highway towards Heathcote/Wollongong
 - Continue through Heathcote (25.6km) and Waterfall (31.1km) - move to right lane
 - 32.0km - After Waterfall, take exit to right onto Old Princes Highway
 - 34.9km - Turn Right into Woronora Dam Road – Gates open at 10.00am.
 - 42.0km – entry to Woronora Dam area – keep to the right.
 - Proceed over the single lane bridge
 - 42.3km - Turn right into either of two parking areas. Which one did we park in in 1976?
 - 42.4km – Covered picnic area, benches and BBQ's. How many Model T's were on the Inaugural Run?

- 0.0km - After lunch, continue back along Woronora Dam Road
 - 7.5km - Turn Left onto Old Princes Highway
 - Continue through Waterfall (11.3km), Heathcote (16.8km), Engadine (18.9km) to Loftus.
 - 23.5km – continue past the turnoff on the right to the National Park.
 - After rail level crossing, veer left at lights (23.5km), and then turn left into Pitt Street (23.7km) for Sydney Tram Museum.
 - Tramway Museum is on the corner Rawson Avenue (Old Princes Hwy) and Pitt Street

Open from 10am to 5pm – last tram to National Park @ 4.15pm
