

Mountains to Mountains Tour 2014

Friday 31 October 2014 - Tuesday 4 November 2014

- 9.30am
Friday
31/10/14** Meet at Glenbrook Information Centre. Travel on Great Western Highway, stopping at Harley Village for Morning Tea (BYO) and a comfort stop, continuing onto Lithgow(81 klms)
Travelling through Lithgow on Castlereagh Highway for approx 12 klms turning left onto the Mudgee turn off. Continue on for 43klms to Capertee for lunch stop. There is a pub and a general store should lunch be needed. Leaving Capertee, turn right down into the beautiful Capertee Valley to Glen Davis (24 klms of good dirt road). There is a turn to the left to Kandos (turning right will take you to Glen Alice) which is approx 50klms, 8klms which is dirt.
Accommodation is entirely up to you, whether you camp or motel/hotel. Please make you own arrangements.
- 10.00am
Saturday
1/11/14** Meet together for the Rylstone Street festival which starts at 10am. (Rylstone is approx. 7 klms from Kandos). There will be market stalls, craft and food stalls, heritage buildings to view. Those who wish to meet after lunch will drive out to Dunns swamp, a very pretty waterway for afternoon tea. (dirt road).
Accommodation is entirely up to you, whether you camp or motel/hotel. Please make you own arrangements.
- Early
Sunday
2/11/14** An early start travelling from Kandos to Mudgee (51klms), onto Ulan (20klms). Morning tea stop at Ulan rest area. From Ulan to Coolah stopping at Black Stump rest area (65klms), then onto accommodation Binnaway (53klms)
Accommodation is entirely up to you, although Pauline may be able to arrange for accommodation at Caravan Park, so let her know if you plan to stay there.
- At your leisure
Monday
3/11/14** This is your day at your leisure. There are some interesting short runs in the area. A tour of Bilby Blooms native plant may be offered to interested folk as well as a talk on bush tucker. Binnaway is an old railway town and there will be some memorabilia on display for those interested. Coonabarabran is 37 klms away and has a very good information centre and a variety of shops.
Accommodation is entirely up to you, although Pauline may be able to arrange for accommodation at Caravan Park, so let her know if you plan to stay there.
- Tuesday
4/11/14** The C.A.R.S. Club of Coonabarabran are organising a run for us out to the Siding Springs observatory and Warrumbungle Range Mountains. This will be the end of our tour, so you can make your own arrangements for your journey home.
