

## **MTFC – Club Run to Mount Annan Botanical Gardens**

**Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> September:** Explore the stunning & prolific native flower displays, particularly the paper daisies which will be at their peak in September, at the Mt Annan Botanical Garden. There is no entry fee. Opens at 8 am and closes at 5 am. Meet at 9 am at the Liverpool Bicentennial Museum parking area on the Hume Highway & depart at 9.30 am. Or make your own way direct to the main entrance at Narellan Rd, Campbelltown. On entry first visit the Bowden Centre where there is every facility, flower displays and a good place to get your bearings and information. Bring everything you need for walking, cycling, jogging and a picnic. Meet at midday for lunch at the Banksia Garden picnic area at the south west end of Mt Annan where there is a BBQ and toilets. Nearby is the Mt Annan summit track on which you might like to test your fitness. At the top is a great 360 degree view of the local landscape.
